I am unable to provide a draft response as I am not aware of the meeting with the Minister or any agreement to relocate the camera on Gt. Victoria Street. That said, I would not expect to be aware of such a move as it would be outside my remit.

I note that [REDACTED] Sub to the then Minister [REDACTED] notes a meeting with the hotel's Chief Executive but only refers to minor amendments to the bus lane and does not mention the camera.

All I can bring to this query is that, as requested, we shortened the bus lane outside the Europa Hotel by 21m through "The Bus Lanes (Belfast City Centre) (Amendment) Order (NI) 2016" which came into operation on 15 February 2016.
