**Re: Transboundary Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Public Consultation Dalradian Gold Mine Project development, located in County Tyrone on the southern edge of the Sperrin Mountains – Transboundary Representation TBA 1595**

In its letter dated 14 October 2025, the Planning Appeals Commission invited the Irish Mining and Quarrying Society (IMQS) to submit a statement of evidence as the IMQS is a transboundary party to its Transboundary Representation (Ref:TBA1595).

The IMQS accepts that invitation.

In considering its statement, the IMQS has seen the almost 1,600 representations made as well as the representation from Donegal County Council. We take issue with many of the claims and unsubstantiated assertions that have been made. In making this assessment, we consulted with members of our Society, and that included Dalradian Gold Limited.

The IMQS does not wish to incur time and expense in duplicating work that is already on-going, and it is mindful of the Planning Appeals Commission's requests to parties with common cause to pool resources. With that firmly in mind, the IMQS has liaised with its member, Dalradian Gold Limited on the responses to the transboundary representations and have been provided with a copy of Dalradian's response to the issues raised in the representations, a response which we adopt. These also form our own statement, albeit we do not provide further copies in the interests of avoiding duplication of material that you will receive from Dalradian.
