## Ravenhill Road/Ormeau Embankment Pedestrian and Cycle Improvements

The Department for Infrastructure is consulting on the legislation associated with our proposal to deliver enhanced active travel infrastructure along Ravenhill Road and Ormeau Embankment.

The proposal will improve connectivity for cyclists and pedestrians, linking communities in South Belfast from Rosetta and the Ravenhill Road to the proposed Lagan Pedestrian and Cycling Bridge and into Belfast City Centre.

### Key features include:

- Dedicated 3m wide cycle track.
- Enhanced pedestrian footway and additional controlled crossing facilities.
- Improved active travel connections to local schools and amenities.
