

PARKING PLACES ON ROADS AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS – DUNGANNON

The Department for Infrastructure (DfI) proposes to make an Order entitled The Parking Places on Roads and Waiting Restrictions (Dungannon) Order (Northern Ireland) 2026. The Order will increase from 1 hour to 2 hours the maximum time a vehicle may wait in certain parking places in Dungannon and also increase the length of time that must expire before a vehicle can return to that parking place. Vehicles are excepted from the conditions in certain circumstances.

The Order will also revoke and re-enact certain other parking places and waiting restrictions in Dungannon
