

SPEED LIMITS

The Department for Infrastructure (DfI) has made a Statutory Rule entitled “The Roads (Speed Limit) Order (Northern Ireland) 2026” (S.R. 2026 No. 84), which comes into operation on 20th May 2026. The Rule will-

- apply a 30 miles per hour speed limit to a length of **Rossinver Road, Garrison** and lengths of **Benone Avenue, Limavady**;
- apply a 40 miles per hour speed limit to a length of **Clabby Road, Clabby, Sligo Road, Letterbreen, Enniskillen**, lengths of **Benone Avenue, Limavady**, a length of **Ballinlea Road, Mosside** and a length of **Tempo Road, Tempo**;
- extend the length of an existing 40 miles per hour speed limit on a length of **Cromore Road, Coleraine**; and
- revoke a number of other speed limits relating to **Clabby Road, Clabby, Cromore Road, Coleraine, Sligo Road, Letterbreen, Enniskillen, Benone Avenue, Limavady**, and **Doon Road, Tempo**.

Vehicles are excepted from the restrictions in certain circumstances.
