

## **TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEME LITTLE PATRICK STREET, LITTLE YORK STREET - BELFAST**

Notice is hereby given that under ‘Article 65’ of the ‘Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993’ the Department for Infrastructure proposes the installation of traffic calming measures on Little Patrick Street and Little York Street, Belfast to control the speed of traffic.

The works will consist of:

Installation:

- 4 No flat top road humps, various lengths, kerb to kerb width and 62.5mm high
- 1 No junction table top ramp, with a length of 22.2m on Little York Street, a length of 17.6m on Little Patrick Street, 3.7m width and 80mm high.

As indicated in drawing number: LPLY - ZZ – XX – DR – CE - 2027

All road humps will be constructed in accordance with The ‘Road Humps Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1999’. All road markings and signage will be in accordance with the ‘Traffic Signs Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1997’.
