

## **PARKING AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS – Newcastle**

The Department for Infrastructure (DfI) proposes to make an Order entitled The Parking Places on Roads, Loading Bay and Waiting Restrictions (Newcastle) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2026.

The Order will authorise vehicles to park for 1 hour with no return within 1 hour on lengths of Railway Street, Newcastle between 9.00am and 5.30pm on Monday to Saturday. Vehicles are excepted from the prohibitions in certain circumstances. Full details are contained in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the road involved, may be inspected free of charge during office hours within the period below at-
