The U7402 Old Bog Road, Moy (Abandonment and Stopping-Up) Order (Northern Ireland) 2026

Made - - - - 2026

Coming into operation 2027

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1), (3) and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993^(b) (“the 1993 Order”) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of the 1993 Order proposes on the completion of works providing alternative facilities for road traffic to abandon the area of the U7402 Old Bog Road, Moy as described in Part 1 of the Schedule and to stop-up the length of the U7402 Old Bog Road, Moy to vehicular traffic at the line described in Part 2 of the Schedule.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to the 1993 Order.

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the U7402 Old Bog Road, Moy (Abandonment and Stopping-Up) Order (Northern Ireland) 2026 and shall come into operation on 2027.

(2) In this Order “the applicant” means Mackle Snacks Limited whose registered office is situated at 18 Armagh Road, Moy, Dungannon, BT71 7HZ.

Application

2.—(1) The applicant shall carry out such works as the Department considers necessary for the provision of alternative facilities for road traffic and on the completion of works the area of the U7402 Old Bog Road, Moy described in Part 1 of the Schedule shall be abandoned and the length of the U7402 Old Bog Road, Moy shall be stopped-up to vehicular traffic at the line described in Part 2 of the Schedule.

(2) The applicant shall carry out such works as the Department considers necessary to prevent or restrict to such extent as the Department thinks fit, access to the road by vehicular traffic.

3.—(1) All existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus placed along, across, over or under the abandoned area of road and the stopped-up road shall be retained.

(2) All existing rights as to the use or maintenance of such cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus shall be preserved.

PART 1

AREA OF ROAD TO BE ABANDONED

An area of 1,292 square metres of the U7402 Old Bog Road, Moy from its southern junction with Armagh Road extending for a distance of 285 metres in a north-westerly direction, more particularly delineated and shown hatched and coloured red on Map no. IN1/26/592372.

PART 2

LENGTH OF ROAD TO BE STOPPED-UP TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

The U7402 Old Bog Road, Moy at a line at its southern junction with Armagh Road, for a distance of 32 metres in a south-easterly direction, more particularly delineated and marked A-B on Map no. IN1/26/592372.

A copy of the map has been deposited at the Department's Headquarters, 3rd Floor-Area A, James House, Gasworks Site, 2-4 Cromac Avenue, Belfast and at DfI TRAM Southern Division, Lands Section, Marlborough House, Central Way, Craigavon.
