The **Department for Infrastructure (DfI)** is developing proposals for the Newry Inner City Greenway, an Active Travel Signature Project that will create a continuous walking, wheeling and cycling connection between the existing Newry Canal Towpath and Carlingford Lough Greenway.

The project aims to improve active travel connectivity through Newry by providing safer, more accessible and attractive infrastructure, linking communities with key destinations and encouraging healthier and more sustainable travel choices.
