

Following requests from residents and local representatives for the provision of traffic calming measures along Victoria Crescent Wesley Street Low Road and Grand Street our subsequent assessment of this area (incorporating the results of a traffic survey; the recent history of collisions; and environmental factors) indicates that this area has achieved a high enough priority to be included within our traffic calming programme of works.

Our objective, by implementing this scheme, is to control vehicle speeds, improve driver behaviour, and as a result reduce the potential for collisions, particularly those involving more vulnerable road users such as pedestrians and cyclists who use the area.

Details of the proposals are shown on the small plan overleaf.

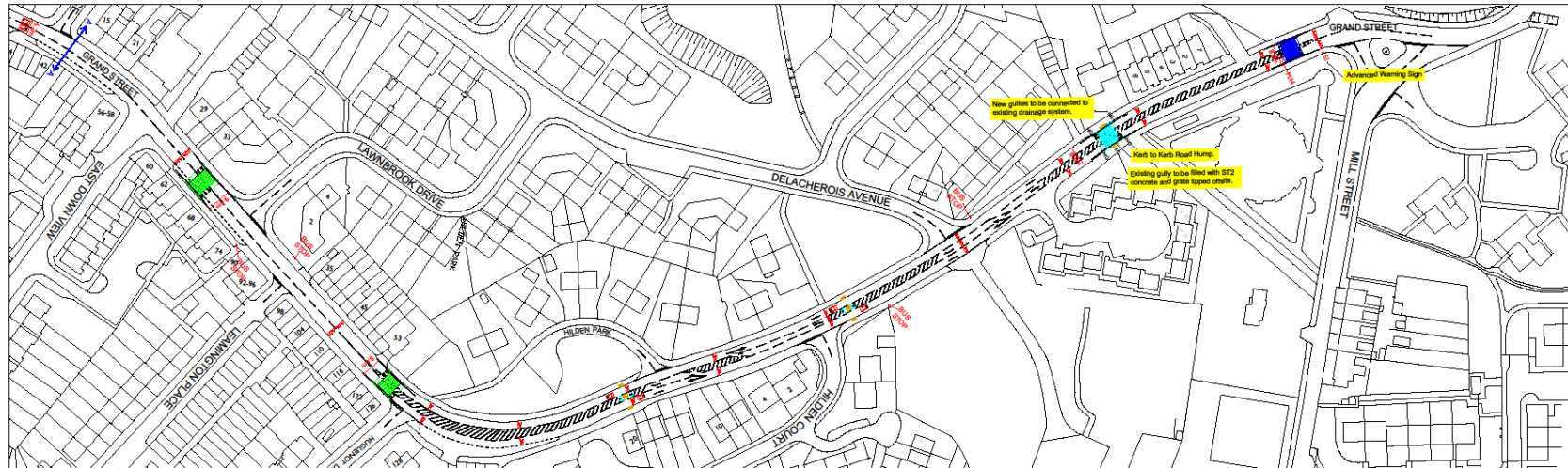
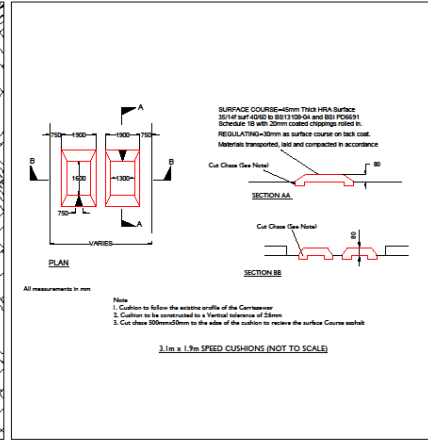
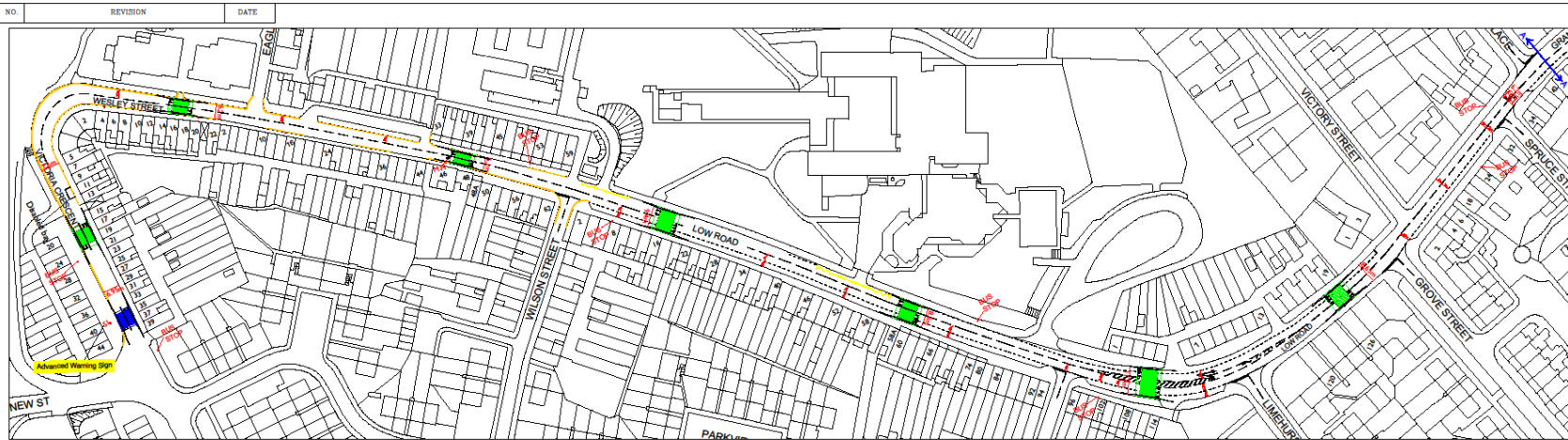
