The Pond Park Road and Beanstown Road, Lisburn (Stopping-Up) Order (Northern Ireland) 2018

Made - - - - 2018

Coming into operation - 2018

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of its powers conferred by Article 68(1), (3) and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) 1993^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order proposes on the completion of works providing alternative facilities for road traffic to stop-up Pond Park Road and Beanstown Road, Lisburn to vehicular traffic at the lines described in the Schedule.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as The Pond Park and Beanstown Road, Lisburn (Stopping-Up) Order (Northern Ireland) 2018 and shall come into operation on 2018.

(2) In this Order “the developer” means North Lisburn Development Consortium Limited whose registered office is situated at c/o Carson McDowell Solicitors, Murray House, Murray Street, Belfast, BT1 6DN.

Application

2.—(1) The developer shall carry out such works as the Department considers necessary for the provision of road traffic and on the completion of works Pond Park Road and Beanstown Road, Lisburn shall be stopped-up to vehicular traffic at the lines described in the Schedule.

(2) The developer shall carry out such works as it considers necessary to prevent or restrict to such extent as the Department thinks fit, access to the roads by vehicular traffic.

3.—(1) All existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus placed along, across, over or under the roads shall be retained.

(2) All existing rights as to the use or maintenance of such cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus shall be preserved.

SCHEDULE

Article 2(1)

ROADS TO BE STOPPED UP TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Pond Park Road, Lisburn, at a line commencing at a point on the south-west side of Pond Park Road 51 metres south-east of its junction with Beanstown Road and extending for a distance of 10 metres in a north-easterly direction more particularly delineated and marked A-B on map no. IN1/18/217370.

2. Beanstown Road, Lisburn, at a line commencing at a point on the south side of Beanstown Road 8.5 metres south-west of its junction with Pond Park Road and extending for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction more particularly delineated and marked C-D on map no. IN1/18/217370.

3. Pond Park Road, Lisburn, at a line commencing at a point on the west side of Pond Park Road 32 metres north of its junction with Beanstown Road and extending for a distance of 84 metres in a northerly direction to a point 116 metres north of that junction on the east side of Pond Park Road, more particularly delineated and marked E-F on map no. IN1/18/217370.

A copy of the map has been deposited at the Department's Headquarters, Room 301, Clarence Court, 10-18 Adelaide Street, Belfast and at DfI Roads Eastern Division, Lands Section, Annexe 7, Block 2, Castle Buildings, Stormont Estate, Upper Newtownards Road, Belfast.
