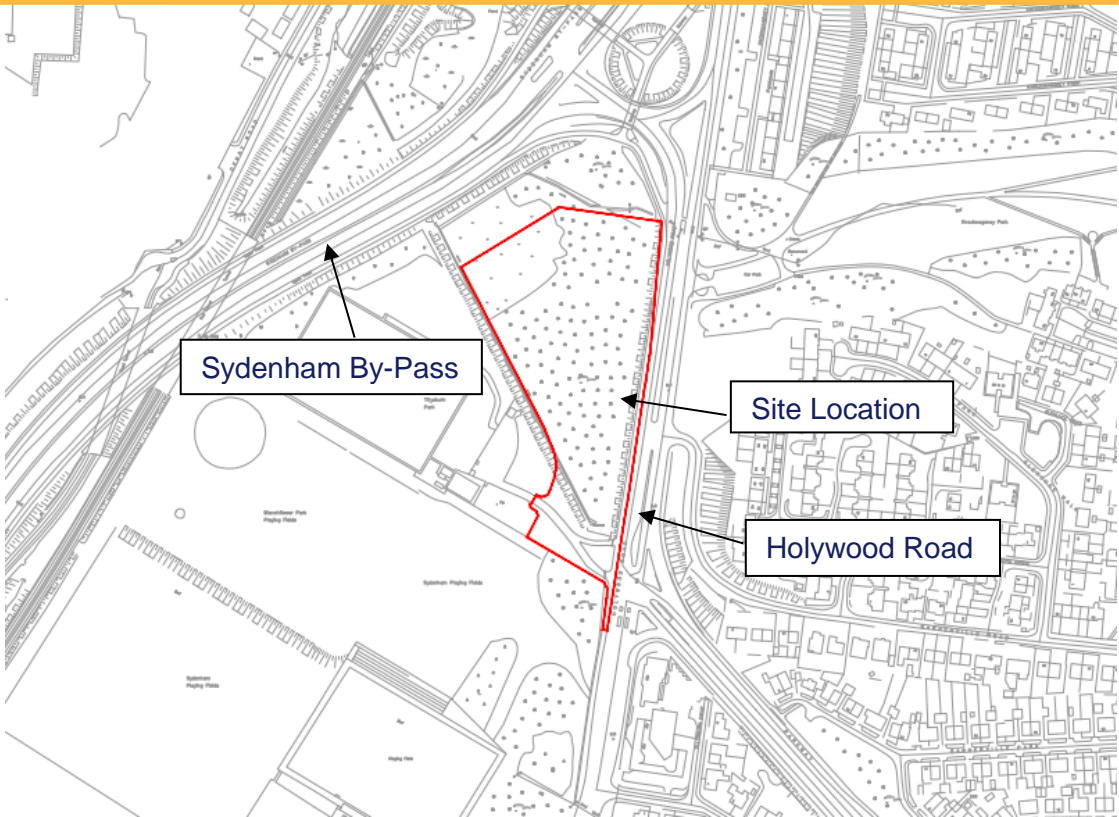


INVITATION TO A PRE-APPLICATION COMMUNITY CONSULTATION

The Department for Infrastructure are proposing to build a Park and Ride facility incorporating approximately 520 parking spaces as part of advanced works to provide improved public transport options for commuters during the proposed York Street Interchange construction works.

Site Location - Lands at Tillysburn, bounded by the A2 Sydenham By-Pass and the Holywood Road, located to the north of H & W Welders' Football & Social Club, Belfast BT4.
