Gowdystown Road Junction

Three proposed flyover type junctions are being considered at the junction of Gowdystown Road with the A1.


The Purple and Pink Options provide a flyover to the south of, and connect into, the existing Gowdystown Road; whereas in the Green Option the flyover bridge is located to the north.

The Green and Pink options both have a direct impact upon property and would each necessitate the demolition of a single dwelling in their construction. The flyover in the Purple Option has been extended to avoid directly impacting upon the dwelling to the south of Gowdystown Road.

Each option includes a new section of public road to connect the old section of Banbridge Road with the proposed junction and facilitate the closure of its junction to the north of Gowdystown Road.

The earthworks footprints shown in these drawings, while indicative, are intended to illustrate what is currently expected to be the maximum extent of the works. However, it is important to note that all options are preliminary at this stage and will be subject to change as the proposal develops.
