**ROADS  
ROUTE A4 SLIGO ROAD, ENNISKILLEN (ABANDONMENT) ORDER  
(NORTHERN IRELAND) 2000**

Made	26 <sup>th</sup> May	2000
Coming into operation	11 <sup>th</sup> July	2000

WHEREAS the Department for Regional Development<sup>(a)</sup> in accordance with Article 68(4) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993<sup>(b)</sup> is of the opinion that another road is available which provides alternative facilities for road traffic;

AND WHEREAS notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order;

AND WHEREAS 3 objections were received and subsequently withdrawn;

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993 and now exercisable by it<sup>(c)</sup> and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Route A4 Sligo Road, Enniskillen (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2000 and shall come into operation on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2000.

Application

2. The area of road described in the Schedule is hereby abandoned.

3.—(1) All existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus placed along, across, over or under the abandoned area of road shall be retained.

## **SCHEDULE**

### **AREA OF ROAD TO BE ABANDONED**

Approximately 1375 square metres of superseded Route A4 Sligo Road, Enniskillen in the townland of Carrigan and County of Fermanagh more particularly delineated and shown hatched on Map No 10/1/37/99.
