



**Notice Of Proposed
Drainage Scheme Not Likely
To Have Significant Effects
On The Environment**

**Glenbrook River Flood Alleviation Scheme,
Cregagh Road Area, East Belfast, Co. Down**

The Department for Infrastructure hereby gives notice, in pursuance of Article 12A of the Drainage (Northern Ireland) Order 1973 (as amended) that it proposes to carry out flood alleviation works on the Glenbrook River in East Belfast.

There is significant flood risk associated with the existing watercourse infrastructure. Drainage improvement works are required to improve the standard of protection and alleviate the risk of flooding.

The purpose of the scheme is to protect properties located at Cregagh Road, Downshire Park Central, Downshire Parade, Downshire Park North, Downshire Park East, Somme Drive, Hamel Drive, and Montgomery Chase from flooding. The proposed works will extend from the junction of Cregagh Road and Downshire Park Central to a tie in point at Montgomery Road and will involve accommodation works to residential properties, replacement of existing Downshire Park culvert (0.9m dia pipe, approx 105m long) with a box culvert (1.2m high by 2.2m wide, approx 135m long), replacement of existing concrete trapezoidal open channel (1.2m wide by 0.75m deep) with a U channel (2.2m wide by 2m high, approx 540m long), replacement of Hamel Drive culvert (1m high by 1.8m wide, approx 11m long) with a box culvert (1.2m high by 2.2m wide, approx 40m long) and a 'L' shape retaining wall (2.9m high by 21m long).

Having taken account of the characteristics of the works in the proposed scheme, their location and potential impacts, the Department considers the proposed scheme is not likely to have significant environmental effects and does not intend to prepare an Environmental Statement.
