Foreword

It is my pleasure to submit to you the Local Transport and Safety Measures, bridges and street lighting draft programme for the Fermanagh and Omagh Council Area for the period 2019-2021.

The draft programme contains proposed schemes generated by requests for improvements from the public, public representatives and schemes identified within Department for Infrastructure Roads. All the proposed schemes have been assessed in accordance with current procedures and are considered to be high priority and represent good value for money. The assessment procedure takes into account a number of factors including cost, traffic volumes and collisions.

You will appreciate that our capacity to deliver schemes within this programme is dictated by availability of funding and based on current funding levels; it will only be possible to deliver a small number of these schemes over the 2019-2021 period. The Division will however continue to bid for additional funding and plan ahead by developing schemes in terms of design and land acquisition to ensure that we are well placed to utilise additional funding should it become available.

Network Development Manager, Harry Gallagher and Network Development Engineer, Colm McElholm, look forward to meeting the Council to present this programme and to hear member's views on it. Opportunity will also be taken to provide updates on the various programmes included within the Spring report as well as on the Strategic Roads projects that affect the area. Network Maintenance Section Engineer (east), Sean Hackett and Network Maintenance Section Engineer (west) Diane Keown, will also be in attendance at the meeting.

I hope you find this report and the presentation interesting and informative.

Carriageway Improvements 2019 – 2021

A509 Derrylin Road at Derryhawlaght - Carriageway Improvement

Location: A509 between Bellanaleck and Derrylin

This is a narrow stretch of road with substandard horizontal and vertical alignment on the A509 between Enniskillen and Derrylin.

This scheme to realign the carriageway will improve road safety for pedestrians, cyclists, motorists and HGVs.

The scheme length is 800m and the estimated cost is £1,200,000. Two phases of surcharging (pre-loading with fill material to expedite settlement of underlying poor ground) have now been completed and the final phase of surcharging will be undertaken in March 2019.


A4 Belfast Road at Dolan's Ring, Enniskillen – Right turn lane

Location: A4 Belfast Road with the junction at Belview Road, Dolan's Ring

There is a recorded injury traffic collision history at this junction involving motorists turning right from the A4 Belfast Road to the Belview Road.

This scheme will provide a right turning lane to improve road safety and this will also improve traffic progression on the A4 Belfast Road. The delivery of this right turn lane is subject to trunk road network resurfacing funding being secured.

The estimated cost of the scheme is £150,000.


<u>U6503 Mill Street / A32 Irvinestown Road, Enniskillen – junction widening to</u> provide additional exit lane for left turning vehicles

Location: U6503 Mill Street at its junction with A32 Irvinestown Road

There is a road safety and traffic progression issue at this junction involving motorists waiting to turn right exiting Mill Street, blocking those waiting to turn left.

This scheme will provide a dedicated left turn slip lane to improve road safety and traffic progression onto the A32 Irvinestown Road.

The estimated cost of the scheme is £30,000.







B48 Glenpark Road, Carriageway realignment and verge provision

Location: B48 Glenpark Road, Gortin Glens, Gortin

The existing road width is restricted with little or no verge and has carriageway slippage on the western side at various locations. A large scale LTSM scheme is proposed that will create a safer and less demanding driving environment for road users, by realigning and moving the carriageway eastwards. This will enable a verge to be provided on the western side and to also improve the forward sight distance.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £300,000.







<u>B48 Gortin Road/C625 Old Mountfield Road and U1528 Strathroy Road, Omagh</u> – Road improvement scheme

Location: B48 Gortin Road/C625 Old Mountfield Road and U1528 Strathroy Road, Omagh

This scheme will widen the existing carriageway to provide a four lane carriageway from the traffic signals at the Old Mountfield Road junction to Arvalee School and the Strule Campus pedestrian access. The existing mini roundabout junction with Strathroy Road will be signalised and two lane approaches will be provided on each arm of the junction. The traffic signals at this junction and the Old Mountfield Road junction will also have Microprocessor Operated Vehicle activation (MOVA) to maximise the efficiency of the network. The Old Mountfield Road approach to the signals will be widened to provide a three lane approach to the junction.

This scheme is being developed in partnership with the Department of Education NI. The estimated cost of this project is £3million.


A3 Cavan Road/U9146 Derrygoas Road - Sightline Improvement

Location: A3 Cavan Road at the junction with U9146 Derrygoas Road, Newtownbutler

There is a restricted sight line to the east at the Derrygoas Road junction.

The scheme objective is to create a safer environment for motorists by improving the visibility splay to the east along the Cavan Road.

The estimated cost for the scheme is £25,000.





Sightline Improvements 2019 – 2021

B50 Castlederg Road/C680 Drumlegagh Church Road - Sightline improvement

Location: B50 Castlederg Road/C680 Drumlegagh Church Road, Drumquin

There are restricted sightlines at Drumlegagh Church Road junction at this crossroads. The scheme will improve the sightlines towards Drumquin. This will improve road safety for all road users.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £40,000.







B80 Tattymoyle Road/C660 Rahoney Road - Sightline improvement

Location: B80 Tattymoyle Road/C660 Rahoney Road, Fintona

The sightline to the southwest of the junction with the Rahoney Road is substandard. The scheme will improve these sightlines therefore improving road safety for all road users.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £30,000.







B122 Tattyreagh Road/C632 Letfern Road, Tattyreagh - Sightline improvement

Location: B122 Tattyreagh Road/C632 Letfern Road, Tattyreagh

There are restricted sightlines at this crossroads. The scheme will improve the sightlines towards Omagh and Fintona. This will improve road safety for all road users.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £40,000.







B80 Tattymoyle Road/C660 Tonnagh, Fintona - Sightline improvement

Location: B80 Tattymoyle Road/C660 Tonnagh Road, Fintona

There are restricted sightlines at this junction. The scheme will improve the sightlines in both directions. This will improve road safety for all road users.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £35,000.

<u>C627 Cloughfin Road/C633Whitebridge Road, Sixmilecross - Improvement to sightline</u>

Location: C627 Cloughfin Road/C633 Whitebridge Road, Sixmilecross

At present there is restricted visibility at this crossroads. Options have been developed to improve the visibility and safety for road users at the C627 Cloughfin Road/C633 Whitebridge Road, Sixmilecross.

The cost of this improvement scheme has been estimated at £150,000.

B80 Cullion Road/U9026 Clarnagh Road, Tempo - Sightline improvements

Location: B80 Cullion Road at the junction with U9026 Clarnagh Road, Tempo.

The existing junction has a restricted sightline to the West when exiting from the Clarnagh Road onto the Cullion Road.

The scheme objective is to create a safer environment for motorists by making alterations to the existing junction layout to improve visibility to the West from the Clarnagh Road junction.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £40,000.


A34 Maguiresbridge Road, Lisnaskea at Major's Bridge – Provision of footway

Location: A34 on Maguiresbridge Road, Lisnaskea

There is no footway at this bridge on the A34 route between Lisnaskea and Maguiresbridge.

This scheme will create a safer environment for pedestrians by providing 30m of footway at Major's Bridge linking Lisnaskea Business Centre to the existing footway network.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £75,000.







<u>A34 Clones Road/Lurganboy Park, Newtownbutler – Provision of new footway</u> link

Location: A34 Clones Road at Lurganboy Park

There is no existing footway link to the bus stop at Lurganboy Park, Clones Road, Newtownbutler. This scheme will provide a safer environment for pedestrians by providing a new footway over a length of approx 110m.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £20,000.







A47 Killadeas Road, Killadeas - Provision of new footway link

Location: A47 Killadeas Road at Killadeas

There is no existing footway link to the Bus Stop on Killadeas Road for residents living on the Kesh side the Tully Road junction. This scheme will provide a safer environment for pedestrians by providing a new footway over a length of approx 230m.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £30,000.







A34 Main Street, Maguiresbridge - Provision of new Puffin Crossing

Location: A34 Main Street, Maguiresbridge at its junction with Boyhill Road

There is no controlled crossing in the village for children attending the local Primary School. Funding has been secured for this scheme through "Active Travel". This new facility will provide a safer environment for pedestrians wishing to cross the Main Street at this location by providing a new controlled crossing facility.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £30,000.


U8448 Rosscor Road, Belleek - Provision of footway

Location: U8448 leading from Loughshore Road to Rosscor Primary School

There is no footway from the Loughshore Road to Rosscor Primary School.

This scheme will provide a safer environment for pedestrians by widening the carriageway to enable a footway to be provided over a length of 110m.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £100,000.







C409 Crevenish Road, Kesh - Provision of missing Footway link

Location: C409 Crevenish Road, Kesh

There is a missing footway link on Crevenish Road between Numbers 16 and 32, children attending the local primary School have to cross the road at this point or walk along the carriageway. Funding for this new footway link has been secured through "Active Travel and will create a safer environment for pedestrians by providing approx.120m of footway.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £120,000.

B81 Caldrum Road, Derrygonnelly – Proposed footway

Location: B81 Caldrum Road, Derrygonnelly at it junction with Main Street

There is a missing footway link on the eastern side of Caldrum Road from the Main Street to the local Primary School.

This scheme will create a safer environment for pedestrians by providing approx.30m of new footway.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £30,000.







U1271 Killybrack Road, Omagh - Proposed infill footway

Location: Killybrack Road, opposite Circular Road, Omagh

There is a missing footway link from Gortview Close on Killybrack Road along the frontage of houses No. 6 and 6A. This scheme will create a safer environment for pedestrians by providing approximately 58m of new footway.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £20,000.





Footways 2019 – 2021

B4 Drumnakilly Road, Omagh

Location: Hospital Road roundabout

At present there is approx 20m of footway and a pedestrian crossing needed to link the footway on the Hospital Road onto the Drumnakilly Road and Deverney Road

This scheme will create a safer environment for pedestrians by providing approx.20m of new footway and a pedestrian Crossing

The total cost of this scheme is estimated at £10,000


C625 Old Mountfield Road, Omagh

Location: Between Arleston Road and Leisure Centre

The existing well used footway at this location is very narrow and uneven.

This scheme will create a safer environment for pedestrians by providing approximately 390 metres of a new 3 metre wide footway.

The total cost of work is estimated at £80,000.


C665 Camderry Road, Dromore - Proposed Footway

Location: C665 Camderry Road, Dromore

At present there is no continuous footway on the eastern side of Camderry Road from the village to the 30mph speed limit.

The scheme will create a safer environment for pedestrians by providing 305m of footway.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £50,000.


C667 Brookmount Road - Infill Footway


Location: C667 Brookmount Road, Omagh

There is at present only one section of footway missing on the Brookmount Road that connects to the footway network.

The scheme will create a safer environment for pedestrians by providing 30metres of infill footway adjacent to Randall Drive that will complete the footway network in this locality.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £150,000 due to the close proximity of a dwelling house to the required retaining wall.







C625 Old Mountfield Road, Killyclogher - Provision of Footway

Location: C625 Old Mountfield Road, Killyclogher, from the junction with Berkley Heights towards mini-roundabouts

At present there is no adjacent footway linking Berkley Heights to the amenities located in the centre of Killyclogher. The scheme will create a safer environment for pedestrians by providing 140metres of footway on the west side of Old Mountfield Road from Berkley Heights to the mini-roundabouts.

The total cost of the works is now estimated at £120,000.







B168 Aghafad Road, Fintona - Provision of Footway

Location: B168 Aghafad Road from U3533 Ecclesville Way to B122 Ecclesville Road, Fintona

At present there is no footway linking Ecclesville Way to the existing footway on the B122 Ecclesville Road. The scheme will create a safer environment for pedestrians by providing 150 metres of footway on the northern side of the Aghafad Road.

The total cost of the works is now estimated at £80,000.







<u>B48 McConnell's Place/U3000 Castle Street, Omagh – Upgrade of traffic signal installation</u>

Location: B48 McConnell's Place/U3000 Castle Street at Hogg's Head

The scheme will upgrade the existing traffic signals and will include an upgrade from Pelican crossings to Puffin crossings at each pedestrian crossing point.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £50,000.






Cycleways 2019 – 2021

<u>C426 Nutfield Road/A34 Main Street, Lisnaskea – Provision of cycle path & new Toucan crossing facility</u>

Location: C426 Nutfield Road, Lisnaskea / A34 Main Street. From Sylvan Hill to St Ronan's Primary School and St Kevin's College on Nutfield Road

The scheme objective is to provide a safer environment for both pedestrians and cyclists by upgrading the existing footway network to a shared footway/cycle path for approximately 250m along the Nutfield Road and Main Street between Sylvan Hill and the two school Buildings. The scheme has secured funding through "Active Travel and it also incorporates a new Toucan crossing facility on A34 Main Street.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £120,000.







<u>U1271 Glencam Road Omagh-Provision of a new 3.5m wide cycle track</u>

Location; From Highfeilds Place Glencam Road to Junction of Killybrack Road

The scheme objective is to provide a safer environment for both pedestrians and cyclists by providing a shared footway/cycle path for approximately 270m along the Glencam Road to link Killybrack Road to Gortin Road. The scheme has secured funding through "Active Travel.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £120,000.


C431 Teemore Road, Teemore - Traffic calming scheme

Location: C431 Teemore Road, Teemore

Although part of this route is within a 30mph speed limit recent speed surveys indicate that many motorists are travelling in excess of this limit past the school.

This scheme aims to provide speed control measures to reduce vehicle speeds.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £5,000.







The total cost of the works is estimated at £12,000.







The total cost of the works is estimated at £20,000.







The total cost of the works is estimated at £8,000.







Location: B46, Gortin Road, Omagh

The total cost of the works is estimated at £8,000.





Vehicle safety fence 2019 – 2021


A32 Clanabogan Road

Location: A32 Clanabogan Road at Ashbourne Park

There is a steep drop of the verge on the Clanabogan Road at Ashbourne Park.

This scheme aims to provide a vehicle safety fence for approx 170 metres to prevent vehicles from leaving the road at this location.


The total cost of the works is estimated at £15,000.





Omagh Traffic Study - 2019 - 2021

It is proposed to undertake a traffic study of the Omagh urban road's network to review and anticipate current and future traffic demand and to provide minor roadwork's schemes to further improve the safety and capacity of existing roads and junctions, as our resources permit.



Bridge Schemes 2019 – 2021

Location: B36 Dernawilt Rd, approximately 3 miles from Donagh - Bridge number 61615

Description: The Bridge does not meet current loading standards and is in poor condition. It is proposed to replace this structure with a reinforced concrete culvert and provide masonry parapets in keeping with the locality.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £100,000.






Bridge Schemes 2019 – 2021

Location: B127 Newbridge Rd, Lisnaskea – Bridge number 61912

Description: The Bridge does not meet current loading standards and is in poor condition. It is proposed to replace this structure with a reinforced concrete culvert and provide masonry parapets in keeping with the locality.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £150,000.








Rosscor Bridge, Strengthening options study

Location: C710, Rosscor Bridge Road, Belleek – Bridge number 60360

Description: The multi span reinforced concrete bridge does not meet current loading standards and is in poor condition. An options study is required to determine if it can be repaired economically.







Bracky Bridge

Location U1737 Dreenan Road, Drumnakilly, Omagh – Bridge number 61256

Description: This single span reinforced concrete structure sustained foundation scour damage in the floods of August 2017 and later collapsed. In the interests of safety we removed the remaining bridge deck and abutments. The new replacement bridge is currently being designed

The total cost of the works is estimated at £300,000.








Galloon Bridge

Location U119 Galloon Road, Newtownbutler – Bridge number 60725

Description: Deck waterproofing and resurfacing has already been carried out, in advance of the planned repairs and strengthening of this reinforced concrete bridge

The total cost of the works is estimated at £200,000.


Lady Brooke Bridge

Location B127 Newbridge Road, Lisnaskea – Bridge number 60711

Description: It is proposed to carry out bridge investigations with a view to future strengthening and repairs.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £250,000.


Radergan Bridge

Location: C628 Radergan Road, Beragh - Bridge Number 61840

Description: This is a single span reinforced concrete structure that has been found insufficient for current loading standards. There is significant parapet damage and a narrowing of the road at this location.

This bridge will be replaced and the opportunity taken to provide some road widening.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £90,000.







Carnanrancy Bridge

Location: U1242 Aghascrebagh Road, Glenhull, Greencastle - Bridge Number 60295

Description: This is a four span reinforced concrete bridge; it was assessed and found to be unsuitable for present day loading requirements. The works planned for this bridge are concrete repairs and strengthening works.

The total cost of the project will depend on the improvement option chosen.







Priests Bridge

Location: U1508 Leglands Road, Omagh - Bridge No 60918

Description: This is a 3 span masonry arch bridge showing signs of arch barrel deformation. Substantial maintenance work is needed. Planned work includes refurbishment of the structure by gunite & grouting the arch barrels, removing vegetation, pointing any cavities and sealing the bridge.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £50,000.







The total cost of the works is estimated at £40,000.









STRATEGIC ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

A5 Western Transport Corridor (A5WTC)



The A5 Western Transport Corridor (A5WTC) is a Northern Ireland Executive flagship project which aims to provide 85 kilometres (55 miles) of dual carriageway from New Buildings through to the border at Aughnacloy. The A5WTC scheme is currently split into 4 phases as follows (see above map):

- Phase 1A: New Buildings to north of Strabane;
- Phase 1B: south of Omagh to Ballygawley;
- Phase 2: north of Strabane to south of Omagh; and
- Phase 3: Ballygawley to the border at Aughnacloy.

A Public Inquiry administered by the Planning Appeals Commission (PAC) commenced on October 2016 and concluded on December 2016. The Department received the PAC report from this inquiry in May 2017 which recommended that the scheme should proceed in the wider public interest. It also made a series of recommendations to the Department, the vast majority of which the Department has accepted in taking the scheme forward.

In November 2017 the Department published the Department's Statement and Notice of Intention to Proceed with the scheme. The Direction Order, which sets the line of the new road in legislation, was made at this time to include for phases 1A, 1B and 2, i.e. covering the length of the scheme between New Buildings and Ballygawley. The Vesting Order for Phase 1A (New Buildings to north of Strabane) was also made, both Orders coming into effect in early January 2018.

Officials from the Department and its consultants subsequently met with landowners affected by the Vesting Order for Phase 1A during April 2018 to discuss accommodation works.

The legal challenge to the scheme issued in December 2017 is on-going and a date on the substantive hearing in the court has not yet been finalised but is expected before the end of this calendar year. An outcome in favour of the Department could see construction commence in Spring 2019. However, an appeal or unfavourable outcome would delay this further.

A4 Enniskillen Southern Bypass

The Environmental Impact Assessment Report and draft Statutory Orders (Direction Order and Vesting Order) for the scheme were published during week commencing 26th March 2018 with the consultation period ending on 18th May 2018. The preferred route was also displayed at a Public Information day at Waterways Ireland HQ offices, Sligo Road, Enniskillen on 12th April 2018.

A total of 21 no. responses were received during this consultation period, including 2 letters of objection. The Division is currently addressing the issues raised in all responses and will decide on the need for a public inquiry over the course of the next few months. If a public inquiry is not deemed necessary the Department will be in a position to make the Direction Order which would define the line of the new road in legislation and provide planning protection.

Progression of the scheme to construction stage will however depend on the availability of funding and current indicative funding levels are such that no further commitment can be given at this time.

Improvements on the A32 from Enniskillen to Omagh

The Department has in place a Road Improvement Strategy for the A32 Omagh to Enniskillen route. This has identified a number of major schemes which will improve the quality of the route, enhance road safety and reduce journey times for all road users. Two schemes have already been delivered under this strategy, at Shannaragh and Drumskinny, at a cost of approximately £10m. Drumskinny was completed in March 2012 while Shannaragh was opened to traffic in December 2012.

The development of a further road improvement scheme at Cornamuck is at an advanced stage and the Direction Order, which defines the line of the new road in legislation, was made in autumn 2015 with the Vesting Order becoming operational in March 2017. The geotechnical and archaeological ground investigations are complete and the vested areas have been fenced off and the vegetation clearance complete. Contract documents for the main construction contract are currently under development in readiness for procurement should funding become available. The opportunity for funding over the next 2-3 years is being considered.



A32 Cornamuck site clearance works

Design work on the Kilgortnaleague realignment, between Irvinestown and Enniskillen, has also progressed and a Preferred Corridor has been identified. Alignment Options within the Preferred Corridor are currently being developed for consultation.

The progression of further improvement works on the A32 will depend on the outcome of future budgetary settlements.

Strathroy Link Road



The previous DENI Minister, Mr John O'Dowd MLA, agreed in July 2013 to fund the construction and lands related costs associated with the Strathroy Link Road. This agreement acknowledged the planning condition attached to the proposed Strule Shared Education Campus which, when complete, would facilitate 5 secondary / grammar schools and one special needs school, with total pupil attendance in the region of 4,000 pupils.

Construction and lands related costs for Strathroy Link Road are anticipated to be in the region of £6.5m to £7.5m. The Department for Infrastructure's commitment to make a contribution of approximately £1m to the project is being implemented through the ongoing management and delivery of the construction contract through the provision of engineering consultancy services.

Given the commitment to part-fund the project the Department sought and secured planning permission for the link road and made the Vesting Order for the necessary lands in March 2017. The contract for construction works was awarded to Fox Contracts of Carrickmore in June 2017.

Site works commenced in September 2017. The replacement of Hunters Crescent Floodwall, which is included within the contract, is now substantially complete and it is anticipated that overall scheme will be completed in July 2019.

This will be used to continue our general programme of improvement/replacement of older systems and the installation of additional energy efficient LED lanterns.
