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# **WORKS PROGRAMME UPDATE AUTUMN 2018**

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#### **Foreword**

It is my pleasure to submit to you the Local Transport and Safety Measures, Bridges and Street Lighting draft programme for the Fermanagh and Omagh Council Area for the period 2020-2022.

The draft programme contains proposed schemes generated by requests for improvements from the public, public representatives and schemes identified within Department for Infrastructure Roads. All the proposed schemes have been assessed in accordance with current procedures and are considered to be high priority and represent good value for money. The assessment procedure takes into account a number of factors including cost, traffic volumes and collisions.

You will appreciate that our capacity to deliver schemes within this programme is dictated by availability of funding and based on current funding levels; it will only be possible to deliver a small number of these schemes over the 2020-2022 period. The Division will however continue to bid for additional funding and plan ahead by developing schemes in terms of design and land acquisition to ensure that we are well placed to utilise additional funding should it become available.

The Strathroy Link Road in Omagh has recently opened to traffic. Predominantly funded by the Department of Education this £7 million scheme is already proving to be an attractive route for those wishing to move in and around the northern area of the town. Other notable projects completed this year include Major's Bridge replacement and widening in Lisnaskea, Lough Yoan Road cycle path Enniskillen, a new footway at Aghafad Road Fintona, A4 resurfacing and new right turning lane at Dolan's Ring and resurfacing of the A5 Beltany Road near Omagh.

At this time, the Department's budget for the current year does not provide for a full street lighting repair service and we are only able to provide a limited maintenance service where electrical/structural hazards will be dealt with first. Other defects will be repaired as resources allow and we are currently not able to repair all street lighting defects that are identified. I would ask for your understanding at this time.

The structural maintenance budget for Northern Ireland is currently £104 million against an annual requirement of some £143 million and this includes £10m set aside for a 'roads recovery fund' which is being used to address localised areas of immediate need across the road network. Of this £1.24m has been allocated to the Fermanagh and Omagh Council area. The Department will continue to identify those roads in most need of repair and prioritise this work alongside other ongoing priorities.

Network Development Manager, Harry Gallagher and Network Development Engineer, Colm McElholm, look forward to meeting the Council to present this programme and to hear member's views on it. Opportunity will also be taken to provide updates on the various programmes included within the Spring report as well as on the Strategic Roads projects that affect the area. Network Maintenance Civil Eng. Assistant (east), Leo Owens and Network Maintenance Section Engineer (west) Diane Keown, will also be in attendance at the meeting.

I hope you find this report and the presentation interesting and informative.

# A509 Derrylin Road at Derryhawlaght - Carriageway Improvement

## Location: A509 between Bellanaleck and Derrylin

This is a narrow stretch of road with substandard horizontal and vertical alignment on the A509 between Enniskillen and Derrylin.

This scheme to realign the carriageway will improve road safety for pedestrians, cyclists, motorists and HGVs.

The scheme length is 800m and the estimated cost is £1,200,000. Two phases of surcharging (pre-loading with fill material to expedite settlement of underlying poor ground) have now been completed with the final phase of surcharging undertaken in March 2019. The ongoing monitoring period to assess settlement at the site will be reviewed again in December 2019.


# <u>U6513 Castlecoole Road, Enniskillen – carriageway widening scheme</u>

# Location: Castlecoole Road at its junction with A32 Tempo Road/Wickham Place

There are road safety and traffic progression issues at this junction involving motorists turning right from Castlecoole Road onto the Tempo Road.

This scheme will provide a right turning lane to improve road safety and improve traffic progression from Castlecoole Road and it will also improve the sightlines from Breandrum Park.

The estimated cost of the scheme is £65,000.


# <u>U6503 Mill Street / A32 Irvinestown Road, Enniskillen – junction widening to</u> provide additional exit lane for left turning vehicles

## Location: U6503 Mill Street at its junction with A32 Irvinestown Road

There is a road safety and traffic progression issue at this junction involving motorists waiting to turn right exiting Mill Street, blocking those waiting to turn left.

This scheme will provide a dedicated left turn slip lane to improve road safety and traffic progression onto the A32 Irvinestown Road.

The estimated cost of the scheme is £30,000.







### **B48 Glenpark Road, Carriageway realignment and verge provision**

## Location: B48 Glenpark Road, Gortin Glens, Gortin

The existing road width is restricted with little or no verge and has carriageway slippage on the western side at various locations. A large scale LTSM scheme is proposed that will create a safer and less demanding driving environment for road users, by realigning and moving the carriageway eastwards. This will enable a verge to be provided on the western side and to also improve the forward sight distance.

The total cost of the works is estimated at more than £300,000.







# <u>B48 Gortin Road/C625 Old Mountfield Road and U1528 Strathroy Road, Omagh</u> – Road improvement scheme

# Location: B48 Gortin Road/C625 Old Mountfield Road and U1528 Strathroy Road, Omagh

This scheme will widen the existing carriageway to provide a four lane carriageway from the traffic signals at the Old Mountfield Road junction to Arvalee School and the Strule Campus pedestrian access. The existing mini roundabout junction with Strathroy Road will be signalised and two lane approaches will be provided on each arm of the junction. The traffic signals at this junction and the Old Mountfield Road junction will also have Microprocessor Operated Vehicle Activation (MOVA) to maximise the efficiency of the network. The Old Mountfield Road approach to the signals will be widened to provide a three lane approach to the junction.

This scheme is being developed in partnership with the Department of Education NI. The estimated cost of this project is £3 million. Planning approval has been sought for the project.

# A3 Cavan Road/U9146 Derrygoas Road - Sightline Improvement

# Location: A3 Cavan Road at the junction with U9146 Derrygoas Road, Newtownbutler

There is a restricted sightline to the east at the Derrygoas Road junction.

The scheme objective is to create a safer environment for motorists by improving the visibility splay to the east along the Cavan Road.

The estimated cost for the scheme is £25,000.


### **B52 Marble Arch Road/A32 Swanlinbar Road – Sightline Improvement**

# Location: B52 Marble Arch Road, Drumlaghey, at its junction with A32 Swanlinbar Road, Florencecourt

There is poor forward sight distance to this junction for motorists travelling from Florencecourt village towards A32 Swanlinbar Road due to the presence of a high bank and hedge. This also restricts the sightline towards Enniskillen at the junction.

The scheme objective is to create a safer environment for motorists by improving the forward sight distance and visibility splay at this junction.

The estimated cost for the scheme is £40,000.







# B80 Tattymoyle Road/C660 Rahoney Road - Sightline improvement

# Location: B80 Tattymoyle Road/C660 Rahoney Road, Fintona

The sightline to the southwest of the junction with the Rahoney Road is substandard. The scheme will improve these sightlines therefore improving road safety for all road users.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £30,000.

# Location: B80 Tattymoyle Road/C660 Tonnagh Road, Fintona

There are restricted sightlines at this junction. The scheme will improve the sightlines in both directions. This will improve road safety for all road users.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £35,000.

# <u>C627 Cloughfin Road/C633Whitebridge Road, Sixmilecross - Improvement to sightline</u>

# Location: C627 Cloughfin Road/C633 Whitebridge Road, Sixmilecross

At present there is restricted visibility at this crossroads. Options have been developed to improve the visibility and safety for road users at the C627 Cloughfin Road/C633 Whitebridge Road, Sixmilecross.

The cost of this improvement scheme has been estimated at £150,000.


# B80 Cullion Road/U9026 Clarnagh Road, Tempo - Sightline improvements

# Location: B80 Cullion Road at the junction with U9026 Clarnagh Road, Tempo

The existing junction has a restricted sightline to the west when exiting from the Clarnagh Road onto the Cullion Road.

The scheme objective is to create a safer environment for motorists by making alterations to the existing junction layout to improve visibility to the west from the Clarnagh Road junction.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £40,000.


# <u>A34 Lisnagole Road, Lisnaskea at Major's Bridge – Provision of footway link</u>

### Location: A34 Lisnagole Road, Lisnaskea

There is no footway between Major's bridge on the A34 Lisnagole Road between Lisnaskea and the local business centre.

This scheme will create a safer environment for pedestrians by providing 100m of missing footway link between Major's Bridge and the Lisnaskea Business Centre to the existing footway network.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £30,000.







# **Location: A34 Clones Road at Lurganboy Park**

There is no existing footway link to the bus stop at Lurganboy Park, Clones Road, Newtownbutler. This scheme will provide a safer environment for pedestrians by providing a new footway over a length of approx 110m.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £35,000.







## Location: A47 Killadeas Road at Killadeas

There is no existing footway link to the bus stop on Killadeas Road for residents living on the Kesh side the Tully Road junction. This scheme will provide a safer environment for pedestrians by providing a new footway over a length of approx 200m.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £30,000.


# **U8448 Rosscor Road, Belleek - Provision of footway**

# Location: U8448 leading from Loughshore Road to Rosscor Primary School

There is no footway and a narrow carriageway from the Loughshore Road to Rosscor Primary School.

This scheme will provide a safer environment for pedestrians by widening the carriageway to enable a footway to be provided over a length of 110m.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £150,000.

# **B81 Caldrum Road, Derrygonnelly – Proposed footway**

# Location: B81 Caldrum Road, Derrygonnelly at it junction with Main Street

There is a missing footway link on the eastern side of Caldrum Road from the Main Street to the local Primary School.

This scheme will create a safer environment for pedestrians by providing approx. 30m of new footway.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £25,000.


# C665 Camderry Road, Dromore - Proposed Footway

# **Location: C665 Camderry Road, Dromore**

At present there is no continuous footway on the eastern side of Camderry Road from the village to the 30mph speed limit.

The scheme will create a safer environment for pedestrians by providing 305m of footway. A portion of this footway is developer led and this scheme will only progress when the developer led scheme is completed.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £50,000.


# C667 Brookmount Road - Infill Footway

# Location: C667 Brookmount Road, Omagh

There is at present only one section of footway missing on the Brookmount Road that connects to the footway network.

The scheme will create a safer environment for pedestrians by providing 30 metres of infill footway adjacent to Randall Drive that will complete the footway network in this locality.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £150,000 due to the close proximity of a dwelling house to the required retaining wall.







# C625 Old Mountfield Road, Killyclogher - Provision of Footway

Location: C625 Old Mountfield Road, Killyclogher, from the junction with Berkley Heights towards mini-roundabouts

At present there is no footway linking Berkley Heights to the amenities located in the centre of Killyclogher. The scheme will create a safer environment for pedestrians by providing 140 metres of footway on the west side of Old Mountfield Road from Berkley Heights to the mini-roundabouts.

The total cost of the works is now estimated at £120,000.







# Location: Farmhill Road, from frontage of house 18 to frontage of house 26

There is a missing footway link from footway to rear of Farmhill Meadows to footway leading to Education Authority bus storage depot. This scheme will create a safer environment for pedestrians by providing approximately 112m of new footway.

The total cost of the works is estimated at £80,000.







The total cost of the works is estimated at £50,000.




# C625 Old Mountfield Road, Omagh

The total cost of work is estimated at £80,000.







The total cost of the works is estimated at £170,000.







The existing damaged section of VRS at this location will be replaced and set back along with the boundary fence line to provide improved visibility when exiting this junction.


The scheme aims to replace and set back approx. 160m of vehicle safety fence which in turn will provide 4.5m x 160m visibility splays at this location.

It is proposed to undertake a traffic study of the Omagh urban road's network to review current and anticipate future traffic demand and to provide minor roadwork's schemes to further improve the safety and capacity of existing roads and junctions, as resources permit.








Description: The multi span reinforced concrete bridge does not meet current loading standards and is in poor condition. An options study is required to determine if it can be repaired economically.










Description: Deck waterproofing and resurfacing has already been carried out, in advance of the planned repairs and strengthening of this reinforced concrete bridge.







Description: It is proposed to carry out bridge investigations with a view to future strengthening and repairs.







This bridge will be replaced and the opportunity taken to provide some road widening.







The total cost of the project will depend on the improvement option chosen.







Description: This town centre bridge has metal painted parapets. The work planned for this bridge is to provide a new protective (painted) coating.







# 2019-2020 PLANNED WORKS PROGRAMME UPDATE AUTUMN 2019

#### STRATEGIC ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

## **A5 Western Transport Corridor (A5WTC)**



The A5 Western Transport Corridor (A5WTC) is a Northern Ireland Executive flagship project which aims to provide 85 kilometres (55 miles) of dual carriageway from New Buildings through to the border at Aughnacloy. The A5WTC scheme is currently split into 4 phases as follows (see above map):

- Phase 1A: New Buildings to north of Strabane;
- Phase 1B: south of Omagh to Ballygawley;
- Phase 2: north of Strabane to south of Omagh; and
- Phase 3: Ballygawley to the border at Aughnacloy.

In November 2017, the Department published the Department's Statement and Notice of Intention to Proceed with the scheme. The Direction Order, which sets the line of the new road in legislation, was made at this time to include for phases 1A, 1B and 2, i.e. covering the length of the scheme between New Buildings and Ballygawley. The Vesting Order for Phase 1A (New Buildings to north of Strabane) was also made, both Orders became into effect in January 2018.

A legal challenge to the Department's decision to proceed was submitted in December 2017. The Department, having given careful consideration to the provisions of the NI (Executive Formation and Exercise of Functions) Act 2018 and relevant High Court decisions, decided that it was not in the public interest to continue defending the legal challenge. As a result, the above mentioned Direction and Vesting Orders were quashed on November 2018.

Since then, the Department has been carrying out the necessary work to enable a fresh decision on the scheme to be taken. This has included the publication of an addendum to the existing Environmental Statement, followed by a public consultation process that concluded on 17 May 2019. The Department considered all the representations made and in view of the number (264) and nature of the issues raised has decided that a further public inquiry will be necessary. The Planning Appeals Commission has now been appointed to administer the public inquiry. The Public Inquiry is scheduled to open on 18 February 2020.

At the point where a new decision is ready to be made, the Department will consider whether to issue a decision taking account of the provisions of the relevant legislation in place at the time. At that time, consideration will also be given to making a new Direction Order (New Buildings to Ballygawley) and a new Vesting Order for Phase 1A (New Buildings to north of Strabane).

Subject to these considerations and any further issues that emerge, construction works on Phase 1A could commence on site in late 2020.

#### **A4 Enniskillen Southern Bypass**

The Environmental Impact Assessment Report and draft Statutory Orders (Direction Order and Vesting Order) for the scheme were published during week commencing 26<sup>th</sup> March 2018 with the consultation period ending on 18<sup>th</sup> May 2018. The preferred route was also displayed at a Public Information day at Waterways Ireland HQ offices, Sligo Road, Enniskillen on 12<sup>th</sup> April 2018.

A total of 21 no. responses were received during this consultation period, including 2 letters of objection. The issues raised in all responses were addressed and the Department concluded that a public inquiry would not be required. Work is on-going around environmental aspects of the scheme which, on completion, will enable a formal decision to be made on whether to proceed with the scheme. Should this decision be favourable, the Department would then be in a position to make the Direction Order which would define the line of the new road in legislation and provide planning protection.

Progression of the scheme to construction stage will however depend on the availability of funding and current indicative funding levels are such that no further commitment can be given at this time.

#### Improvements on the A32 from Enniskillen to Omagh

The Department has in place a Road Improvement Strategy for the A32 Omagh to Enniskillen route. This has identified a number of major schemes which will improve the quality of the route, enhance road safety and reduce journey times for all road users. Two schemes have already been delivered under this strategy, at Shannaragh and Drumskinny, at a cost of approximately £10m. Drumskinny was completed in March 2012 while Shannaragh was opened to traffic in December 2012.

The development of a further road improvement scheme at Cornamuck is at an advanced stage and the Direction Order, which defines the line of the new road in legislation, was made in autumn 2015 with the Vesting Order becoming operational in March 2017. The geotechnical and archaeological ground investigations are complete and the vested areas have been fenced off and the vegetation clearance complete. Contract documents for the main construction contract are complete in readiness for procurement should funding become available. The opportunity for funding over the next 2-3 years is currently being considered.

Design work on the Kilgortnaleague realignment, between Irvinestown and Enniskillen, has also progressed and a Preferred Corridor has been identified. Alignment Options within the Preferred Corridor are currently being developed for consultation.

The progression of further improvement works on the A32 will depend on the outcome of future budgetary settlements.

#### **Strathroy Link Road**



The previous DENI Minister, Mr John O'Dowd MLA, agreed in July 2013 to fund the construction and lands related costs associated with the Strathroy Link Road. This agreement acknowledged the planning condition attached to the proposed Strule Shared Education Campus which, when complete, would facilitate 5 secondary / grammar schools and one special needs school, with total pupil attendance in the region of 4,000 pupils.

Construction and lands related costs for Strathroy Link Road are anticipated to be in the region of £6.5m to £7.5m. The Department for Infrastructure's commitment to make a contribution of approximately £1m to the project is being implemented through the ongoing management and delivery of the construction contract through the provision of engineering consultancy services.

Given the commitment to part-fund the project the Department sought and secured planning permission for the link road and made the Vesting Order for the necessary lands in March 2017. The contract for construction works was awarded to Fox Contracts of Carrickmore in June 2017.

Site works commenced in September 2017. The replacement of Hunters Crescent Floodwall, which is included within the contract, was complete in August 2018. The new link road was opened to traffic on Friday the 8 of November 2019.
