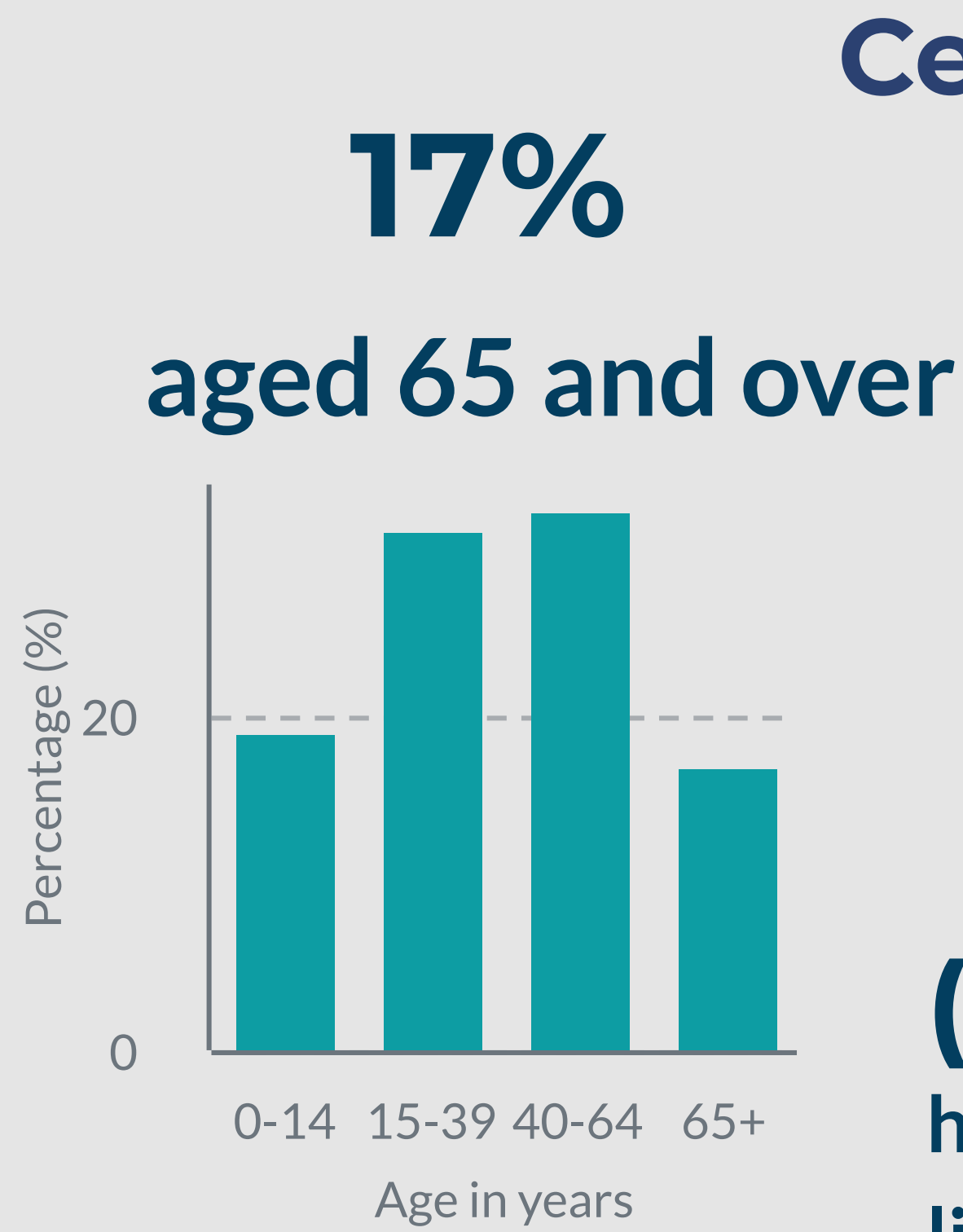
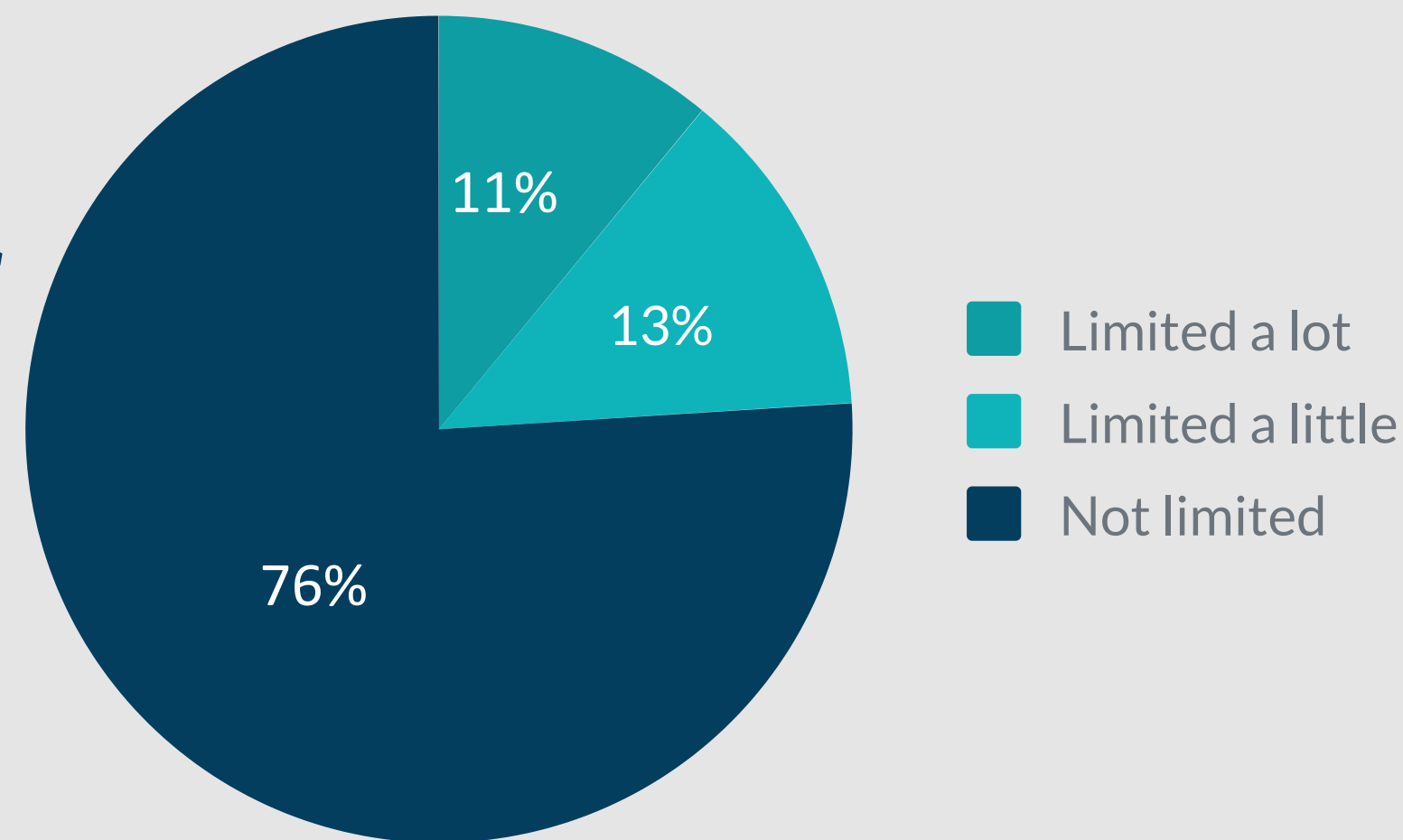

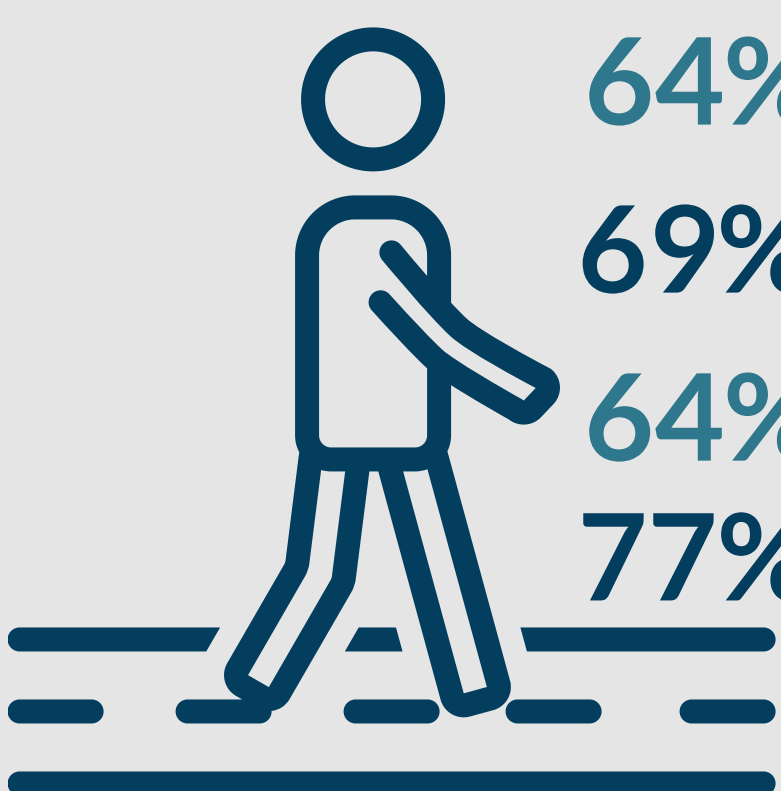

Walking



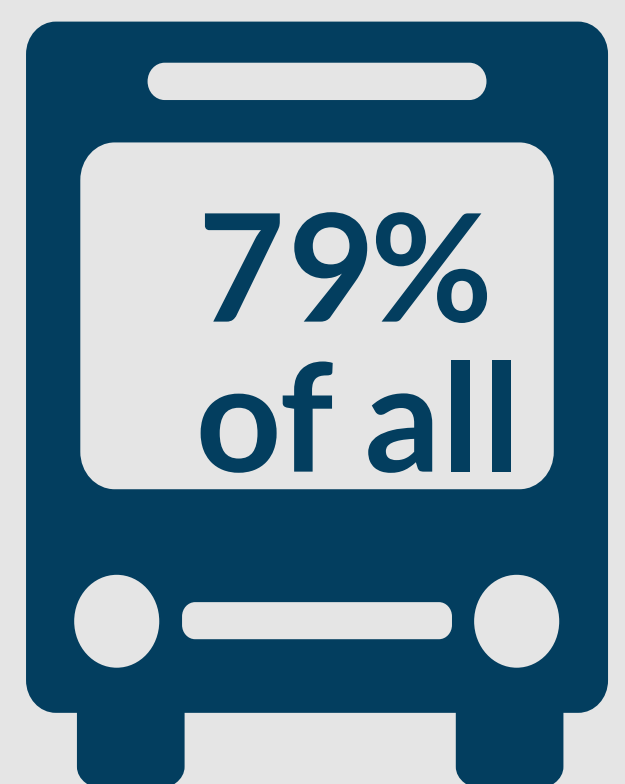

In terms of satisfaction with the current situation for cycling, there was no significant difference between the results for those with (44%) or without (47%) a disability. For satisfaction with public transport facilities, there was no significant difference between responses for those with a disability (78%) and those without a disability (80%) or between responses for those aged 16 to 24 (87%) and those aged 65 and over (83%).

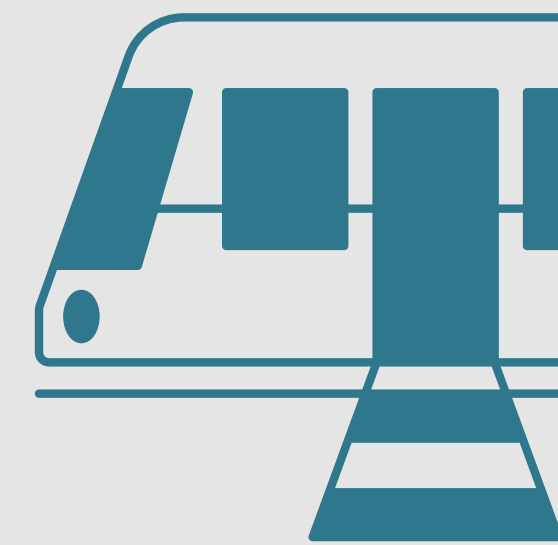
